Step-by-Step Directions for Android Users

Step	What to Do	Details
1	Open your phone camera.	Point your Android camera at the QR code on this page.
2	Tap the calendar link that appears.	A notification or small link should pop up on your screen. Tap it to open the calendar.
3	Choose how you want to open it.	If your phone asks, choose Google Calendar, Chrome, or your preferred browser.
4	Tap Add Calendar or Subscribe.	Depending on your Android phone, it may say Add Calendar, Subscribe, or Open in Google Calendar.
5	Confirm the calendar is visible.	Open the Google Calendar app, tap the three lines in the top left, and make sure the studio calendar is checked.
6	Check the calendar anytime.	Parents can return to this calendar 24/7 to see the daily schedule and any updates.

If It Does Not Open Automatically

- Make sure the Google Calendar app is installed or updated on your Android phone.
- Try opening the QR code link in Chrome first, then select Google Calendar if prompted.
- In the Google Calendar app, tap the menu icon and make sure the studio calendar box is checked.
- Save this document or take a screenshot of the QR code so you can access the schedule anytime.

Step-by-Step Directions for iPhone Users

Step	What to Do	Details
1	Scan the QR Code	Open your iPhone camera and scan the QR code above.
2	Open the Link	Tap the calendar link that appears on your phone.
3	Copy the iCal Link	Copy the iCal subscription link. This allows Apple Calendar to subscribe to the team calendar.
4	Open Calendar Settings	Go to Settings → Calendar → Accounts → Add Account.
5	Choose Add Account	Tap Other.
6	Add Subscribed Calendar	Tap Add Subscribed Calendar.
7	Paste the Link	Paste the iCal link into the Server field.
8	Save	Tap Next, then tap Save.
9	Check Visibility	Open Apple Calendar and make sure the team calendar is turned ON and visible.
10	Stay Updated	The calendar will update automatically when changes are made.

Costs related to Taylor Pacesetters are covered in three ways: Booster Club Membership Dues, Fundraising, and Additional Line Items. All are required to fund the training, costumes, supplies, and overall costs for football and competition seasons.

Booster Club Membership Dues

Required Varsity Dues

The Taylor Pacesetters Booster Club understands that costs continue to rise for families everywhere, and we remain committed to doing our part to help offset expenses whenever possible while still providing an exceptional experience for our dancers throughout football season, competitions, performances, team events, and senior activities.

The actual cost per dancer for the 2026–2027 season is approximately **\$885 per dancer**. However, through careful budgeting, fundraising efforts, sponsorships, and timely financial planning, the Booster Club is able to offer a reduced rate of **\$775 per dancer** for families who remain current on payment deadlines.

Timely payments are extremely important, as many of our expenses must be paid in advance for choreography, costumes, competition fees, meals, supplies, reservations, and team events. When payments are received on time, it allows the Booster Club to continue securing discounts, reducing additional fees, and providing financial support opportunities that ultimately benefit the entire team.

Fundraising

Fundraisers happen throughout the year to minimize out-of-pocket expenses for each dancer.

Every dancer is required to participate in fundraising. At each fundraiser, each young lady will be responsible for selling a minimum amount.

Fundraising Schedule

- **FALL**
 - Corporate Sponsors (July) - Minimum Fundraising Effort each girl must bring in at least one sponsor
 - Sponsor Me (August) – Minimum Fundraising Effort of \$250 each girl
 - Poinsettias (September) - Minimum Fundraising Effort of selling 15 poinsettias each
 - Junior Pacesetter Clinic (October) – girls and parents help
 - Luxury Raffle (Oct/Nov) - Minimum Fundraising Effort of selling 10 tickets each
- **SPRING**
 - Elevation Contest Fundraiser (Feb) – girls and parents help
 - Junior Pacesetter Clinic (April) – girls and parents help
 - Spring Show (May) – girls and parents help
